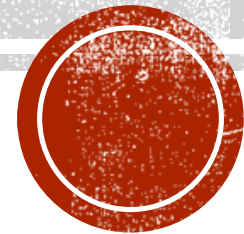


SBA GRADING SYSTEM



What is SBA Grading System?

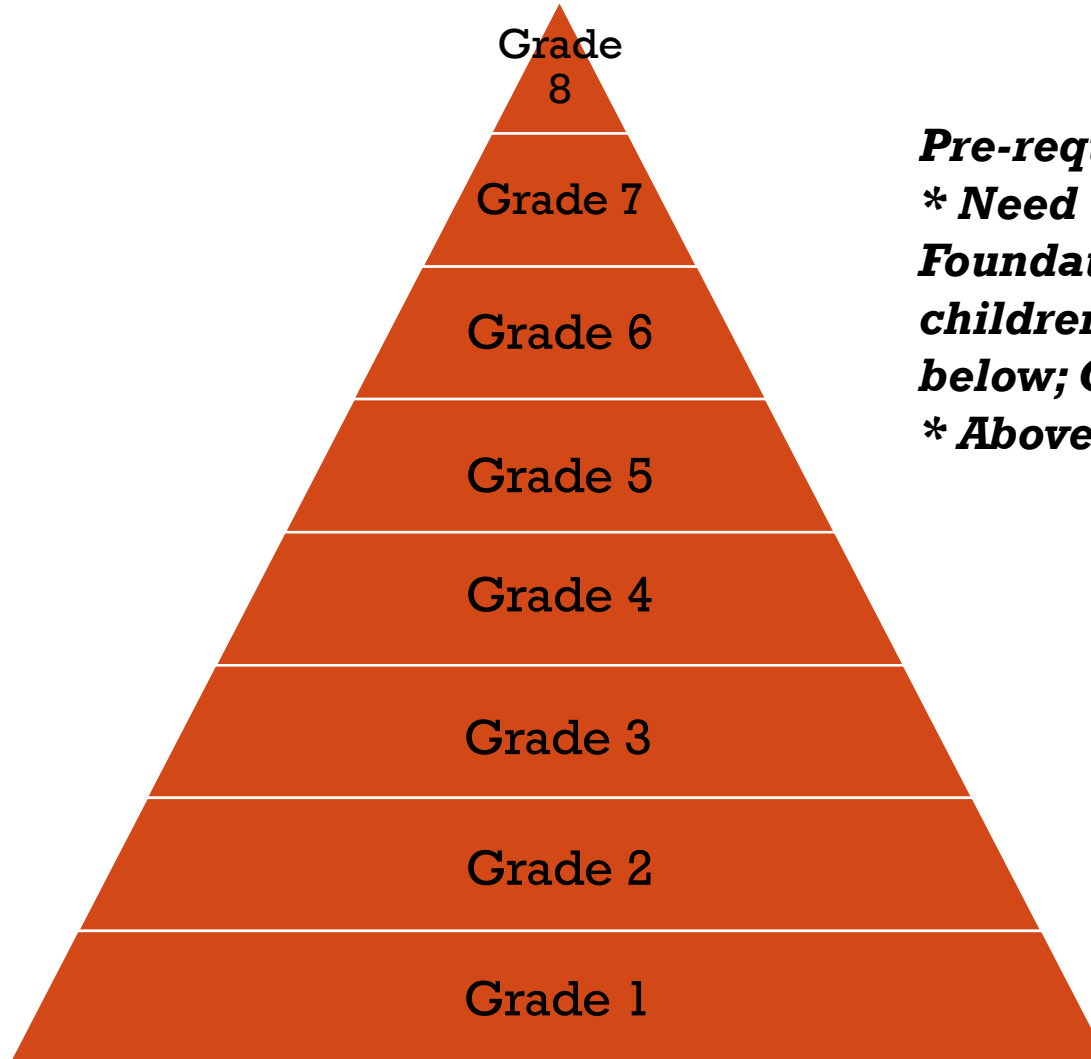
1. An assessment of one's technical and physical ability in Badminton.
2. The complexity of tasks increase in accordance with grade advancement.



SBA Grading System (sample)



Pre-requisites
**** For children 9 years and below***



Pre-requisites
**** Need to complete Foundation 1 to 3 for children 9 years and below; OR***
**** Above 9 years old***



Why introduce SBA Grading System?

1. Adopt a National Standard for Badminton in Singapore
2. Platform for evaluation and feedback of players on their proficiency level to encourage further learning
3. To create a larger talent pool with strong fundamentals
4. A tool for talent identification
5. Introduce tournaments categorised by Grade



Collaboration with SBA

1. To help develop the Grading Test items (Grades) and related materials, e.g. assessment sheets, videos, etc. in consultation with SBA National Grading System Committee.



Selection Criteria

1. To have minimum of 10 years of coaching experience locally (head coach and/or academy).
2. To provide a CV to show coaching experience (both personal and academy) as well as achievements.
3. Coaches to be all NROC registered.
4. Shortlisted candidate/academy has to make a presentation to SBA on its proposed concept on Grading Tests with samples.

Note: SBA reserves the right to reject any application that is incomplete or do not meet the above criteria.
