



PLAYERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

As a player representing Singapore, I:

1. shall uphold the good name of the Republic of Singapore and the SBA, and display exemplary behavior at all times.
2. shall not at any time engage in conduct which will bring or have the tendency to bring myself, the sport of badminton, the Team, any other member of the Team or the SBA into disrepute or censure, or which is or would have the tendency to be inconsistent with, contrary to or prejudicial to the best interests, image or values of the SBA.
3. shall conduct myself so as to obtain and maintain the best possible mental and physical fitness and health of themselves and the Team, to perform to the highest possible standard at the Competition and carry out my duties to the Team to the best of my abilities (where applicable);
4. shall not at any time be convicted of, or charged with, any serious offence involving violence, alcohol or drugs, any sex offence, any offence relating to any gambling activities on sport, or any offence which is punishable by law.
5. subject to the minimum age and other restrictions relating to the legal consumption of alcohol in the country or jurisdiction in which the Competition is held (including in the Hotel and Competition venues), may only consume alcohol after I have completed all my respective matches in the Competition. In doing so, I am to always exercise reasonable restraint so as to avoid the excessive consumption of alcohol such that my behaviour and conduct will bring or have a tendency to bring myself, the Team, SBA or the Republic of Singapore into disrepute.
6. must always consider and respect the interests of other Team members and must not comment or behave in a way which, in SBA's opinion, may be damaging, humiliating or defamatory to the Team, a Team member, the SBA, or any other team or competitor.
7. shall dress appropriately and be punctual for all matches.
8. Shall familiarize myself with the competition programme and be present at the competition venue no later than the time or times stated in the applicable technical regulations or as notified at the respective technical meetings for the purpose of registration and /or competition, as the case may be.
9. shall not argue or otherwise misconduct myself with referees, umpires, judges, opponents or officials. Sportsmanship should prevail at all times.

10. shall not destroy misuse or keep any property not belonging to me and shall not take souvenir items such as towels, ashtrays etc from the hotels or other places.
11. shall not litter and shall be responsible for the cleaning and tidying of my own rooms.
12. shall observe proper standards of personal hygiene and refrain from using foul language.
13. must not gamble and smoke at all times.
14. shall comply with the World Anti-Doping Code.
